

How to care for your new Blueberry bush

1. Remove the bush from its wrapping - but keep root/soil wrapped.
2. It is recommended you get a 15 gallon or larger pot with excellent drainage.
3. Gather needed items: pine bark fines, azalea based fertilizer, soil sulfur & peat moss
4. Mix gathered items thoroughly to the following approximate specifications: 1/2 cup sulfur; 3 tablespoons fertilizer; 8 cups peat moss & 13+ gallon pine bark fines.
5. Place 1/3 of mixture into the pot.
6. Remove wrap from root of bush and place in pot.
7. Add the remainder of the mixture to the sides of bush and fill approximately to 1 inch above root zone.
8. Shake your pot to make sure all contents settle into place.
9. Top off with 1 inch of pine bark mulch and water thoroughly.
10. Water your bush only when the soil is moist to dry - approximately every 3-4 days in tropical climates. (May need to water more frequently in very hot weather)
